

Thank you so much for signing up to trade at our market. Here are some commonly asked questions to help with your day.

The Southsea Girls x The Hideaway market runs the 2nd Saturday of each month (with some exceptions) between the hours of 10am and 3pm.

The aim of the market is to empower and support women from Portsmouth in business. We aim to have a balance of traders with a range of different products to encourage people to shop locally and create a lively atmosphere.

FAQ:

1. When can we set up?

You're able to set up from 9am the morning of the market, or if you would prefer to set up the night before, you can do so, but please be mindful you are responsible for leaving your belongings overnight. Your insurance must cover your own stock and it is not Southsea Girls or The Hideaway's responsibility for any loss or damage. Tables will be setup for your arrival, and can be claimed on a first come first served basis.

2. Where can we unload/park?

You can unload in Hellyer Road and use the side door. There is the option to park down any of the surrounding roads, but double check the road signs for any permits. The roads to the side of the venue are normally ok until 6pm.

3. How many other traders from the same category will there be?

We will only have one of each business category trading at any one market. Should have any last minute availability, then it will be the organisers decision to double up.

4. Do I need any licences?

The producer and stallholder on the day of the market is responsible for complying with all local and national laws and regulations regarding the production, labelling, display, storage, and sale of goods, including complying with any relevant trading standard legislation and Environmental Health and Health and Safety requirements. Photocopies of your public liability insurance must accompany your application and be re-sent upon renewal of your policy each year.

5. Will a table be provided?

Yes, one standard 6ft table will be provided. However, you are welcome to bring your own, please just let us know before the day. You will need to provide your own table cover.

6. When can I pack away?

No stallholders are allowed to pack away before 3pm (when the market finishes). All belongings must be cleared and tables put away by 4pm. You must use the bin provided for any rubbish.

7. When is payment due?

Payment must be made once your table has been confirmed. If you have not paid by the due date, then your booking may be cancelled and your space offered to another stallholder.

Disclaimer of Liability

The organisers and staff shall not be responsible to any person or persons whilst upon the market area, parking, or the access routes off the public highway, for personal injury, fatal or otherwise suffered by such person unless due to any claim or action in respect of any such injury suffered by any person or persons whom the organisers may formally employ or engage.

The organisers and staff shall not be responsible to any person whomsoever for any damage, theft or loss however caused in respect of any exhibits, produce or other property in transit to or from the market or upon the market area or parking area at any time.

Stall holders shall indemnify the organisers from and against all claims and actions in respect of any personal injury whether fatal or otherwise, damage, theft or other loss which may be caused or occasioned in connection with their attendance at and use of or presence at the market and against all costs and proceedings arising there from. 27.08.2024
